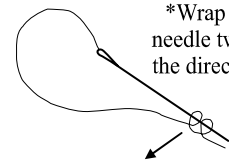

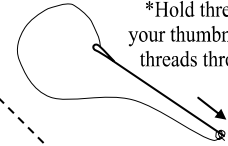


Embroidered square:
Cut 4 1/2"
to finish at 4"

French Knot

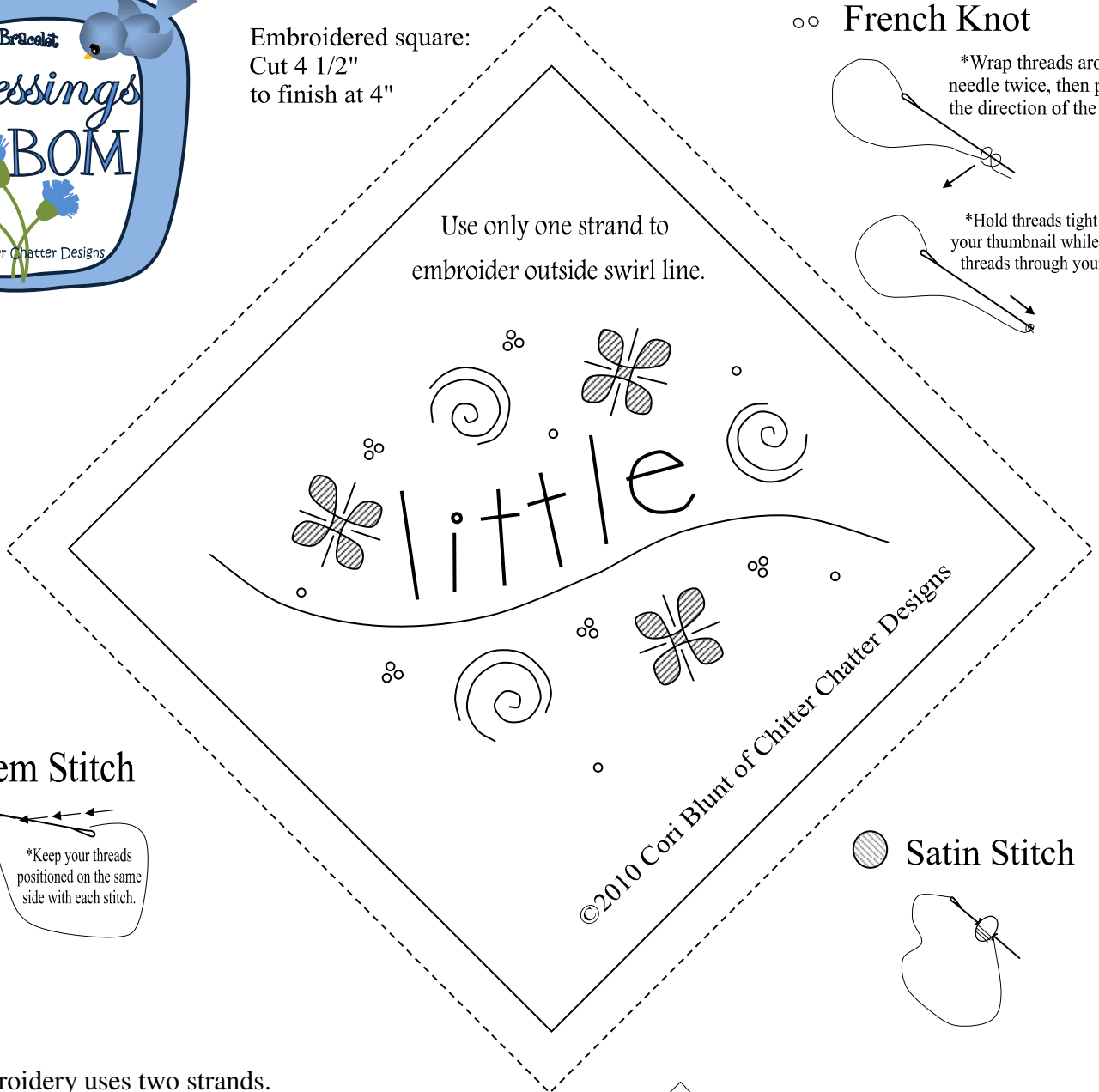


*Wrap threads around needle twice, then pull in the direction of the arrow.

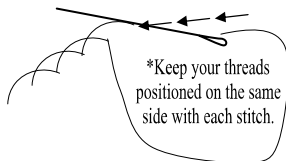


*Hold threads tight with your thumbnail while pulling threads through your knot.

Use only one strand to embroider outside swirl line.

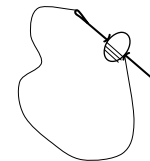


Stem Stitch



*Keep your threads positioned on the same side with each stitch.

Satin Stitch

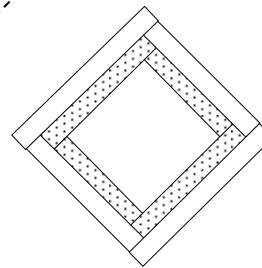


All embroidery uses two strands.

Cut additional fabric as follows:

Print: 2 – 1 1/2”x 4 1/2”strips and 2 – 1 1/2”x 6 1/2”strips,

White: 2 – 1 1/2”x 6 1/2” strips, and 2 – 1 1/2”x 8 1/2” strips.



*Remember to press seams. Seam allowance is 1/4”

Block Assembly: Sew the **print** 4 1/2” strips to each side of the embroidered square, followed by the **print** 6 1/2” strips to the top and bottom. Sew the 6 1/2” strips of **white** to the sides of the square followed by the 8 1/2” strips of **white** to the top and bottom of the square. With seams completed block should measure 8 1/2” square. Finished block size will be 8”square.
