

ROSIE TWEET PILLOW CORRECTION SHEET

Required Items:

6" Square of Blue Fabric

Fat Quarter of Print Fabric

Various scraps of fabric for roses, leaves,
birds,

ribbon and border appliques.

Coordinating Embroidery Floss in green, red,
blue, yellow, black, and white.

Stuffing for pillow.

9" square of Batting

Cutting Instructions:

Cut an 6" square of the blue fabric.

From your fat quarter:

Cut a 9" square;

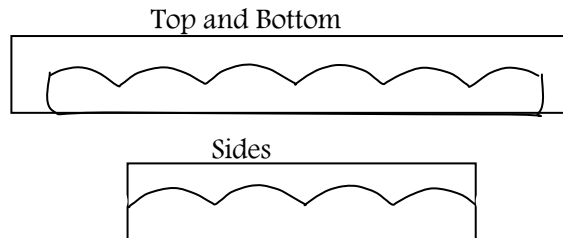
Two 4"x 22" strips;

Two 2"x 6" strips;

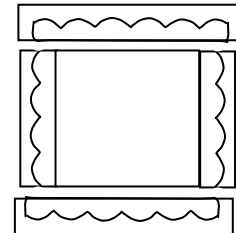
Two 2"x 9" strips.

Making your Pillow: Seam allowance is 1/4".

Use your preferred method to appliqué the scalloped border onto the 2"x 6" strips, and the 2"x 9" strips, adding the 1/4" seam allowance on the side that faces the center of each scallop.



After appliquéing the border strips, sew one of the side strips to each side of the center blue block, followed by the top and bottom strips.



Now you are ready to start appliquéing the center design.

Appliqué your design onto the fabric square following the

numbers provided on the pattern. Embroider as directed.

When appliqué and embroidery are complete, quilt as desired adding batting to the back of your pillow top.

After completing all quilting, begin the pillow construction by making a ruffle.

Ruffle: take the two 4" strips and join together to make one long strip. Fold in half wrong sides together lengthwise and press.
